Physical Therapist Atkinson honored in the Senior Housing and Senior Living category

Saint Louis Park, Minn. (February 26, 2024) – Christina Atkinson, PT, DPT, a native of Dubuque, Iowa, has been named to the Frontline Honors Class of 2024. With nominations in the categories of Behavioral Health, Home Health and Home Care, Hospice and Palliative Care, Senior Housing and Senior Living, and Skilled Nursing, the program showcases exemplary character and performance of frontline workers across the care continuum.
